RELEASE OF THE RESULTS OF PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS FOR GENERAL/ POST BASIC NURSES - NOVEMBER, 2016.

This is to inform you that the results of Professional Examinations for General and Post Basic Nurses held in November, 2016 have been released on Friday 6th January, 2017 by the Nursing and Midwifery Council of Nigeria.

a) General Nurses:
